Main entry/exit points staffed or fitted with electronic access control + PIN 3. Main entry/exit points fitted with CCTV monitoring. 4. Higher security areas within the building to be fitted with additional electronic access control and secondary verification (PIN) at all times. 5. Doors and windows to zone to be fitted with intruder detection or secondary internal PIR alarming. 6. All systems monitored by central control room.
Cat. B	40-59	Would represent:- 1. A disruption to the operation of the Department/School 2. Loss or damage to the reputation of the University or Department/School. 3. Staff and/or students being placed at risk 4. The possibility of University Department/School financial implications.	1. All external doors fitted with appropriate security measures and remote alarm monitoring. 2. Main entry/exit points fitted with electronic access control 3. Main entry/exit points fitted with CCTV monitoring. 4. All systems monitored by central control room.
Cat. C	26-39	Would represent:- 1. A disruption to the operation of the Department/School 2. Loss or damage to the reputation of the Department/School. 3. The possibility of Department/School financial implications 4. Staff and/or students being placed at risk	1. Main entry/exit points fitted with electronic access control 2. Doors and windows to vulnerable areas to be fitted with intruder detection or secondary internal PIR alarming. 3. All systems monitored by central control room.
Cat. D	10 -25	Would represent:- 1. A disruption to the operation of the Department/School 2. The possibility of the loss or damage to the reputation of the Department/School 3. The possibility of Department/School financial implications.	1. Personal key holding to buildings and offices 2. Individual secure storage. 3. Electronic access control measures fitted where appropriate.
Cat. E	Under 10	Would represent:- 1. A localised disruption to the operation of the Department/School	1. Personal key holding
